The meeting was worth attending because we heard about an exciting project which President Elect, Alan Bamford is hoping the club can get off the ground. Indeed, the theme of the presentation was "Turning Your Vision into Reality".

The project for consideration is an event conducted along the lines of a RYLA (Rotary Youth Leadership Award) program, specifically for young people with a medical condition. To assist Alan with the presentation was Kehela "Keels" Vandenberg, herself a RYLA alumnus. From their joint presentation it was evident that a lot of preliminary research has been completed to enable this project to be initiated. All aspects of such an event have been considered. These aspects were summarised for further investigation as follows:

- What? A weekend camp for people 18 to 30 years of age who have a medical condition.
- Why? For the participants a chance to create support networks, improve well-being, increase self-esteem and confidence and develop skills for overcoming obstacles.
- When? Over a weekend (Friday afternoon to Sunday afternoon), probably in summer aiming for the inaugural event late 2012 or 2013.
- Where? A venue that can cater for disabled people, conducive for fun and professional development.

For such an event to succeed, the following is required:

- Organising Committee – Initial organization; setting vision; setting objectives.
- Leadership Team – Create structure; roles for executive, mentors, activity/group leaders; support staff (onsite nurse, youth worker, counselor); future/past participants.
- Other Participants – Guest speakers; activity coordinators; sponsors; post camp debriefers.
- Research – Investigate any similar programs, those who work with young people with medical conditions and those involved in putting together camps/seminars.

Budget – Accommodation; transport; food; materials; meeting/training room booking fees; thank-you gifts.

As you can see, the proposed project offers a large challenge for the club and we may well need other club and/or district involvement. The initial steps have been made with Alan organising a committee: Alan, Graham Shaw and Rob Gagnon. We will be hearing more about this project in the coming months as the above aspects are fleshed out. We all need to assist where possible.

Thanks to Alan and Keels for a well presented "business plan".
